10. Sponsor's Letter of Support

Provide a letter of support from the applicant's research sponsor. This letter of institutional commitment from the applicant's division chief or department chair must verify the award is being used to provide the applicant with protected time for research, that the institution will provide adequate laboratory space and/or other supporting facilities, and that the institution and the applicant will adhere to the terms of the award, including timely and accurate reporting of the awardee's research activities following AGA's progress and financial reporting requirements.

If the applicant's position is not clearly identifiable as a faculty-level position (i.e., anything other than instructor, assistant professor, associate professor, or professor), the sponsor should clearly indicate that the applicant's posisiton is a faculty-level position.
